Hart Cluster is potentially interested in a partnership with Farnham cluster. Communication lines are being kept open as the two clusters could, in the future, amalgamate.</p> <p>Commissioning Intentions at present are</p> <p>Farnham GPCC Cluster plans to work with Surrey Heath and FPH on reducing emergency admissions through the EPIC program which is to start in October 2010. By April 2011, all initiatives will be fully up and running, so we anticipate a full year savings effect in 2011/12. While exact saving targets are developed in the diagnostic phase of EPIC over the next 2-3 months, we anticipate a reduction in Emergency Admissions of roughly 5 – 10 %.</p> <p>We also plan to work with Frimley Park Hospital and its surrounding GP clusters on the Farnham Castle project. Over 50 care pathways have been defined and referral guides are being rolled out. By April 2011 we anticipate all pathways to be fully implemented so a full year’s effect should be achieved in savings. Savings estimates are being developed over the next 2-3 months.</p> <p>We will continue to commission the Farnham practice based InsideVue Ultrasound Service. We estimate local direct access ultrasound activity to be in the region of 2350 scans per annum on current GP referrals. In addition, InsideVue aims to support local initiatives to help reduce referrals by providing a cost effective and rapid diagnostic service.</p>

This item will be discussed again at the next meeting.</p> <p>Andy Brooks (GPCC lead for Surrey Heath, GP in Camberley) gave a local and national overview about commissioning and how they, in Surrey Heath are moving forward. (If anyone would like the slideshow he presented please ask Melanie Eldridge to e-mail).</p> <p>IHP and Dr Margaret Chirgwin Farnham has applied for more funds to allow IHP to initiate new projects. Margaret Chirgwin will work alongside IHP.</p> <p>Agenda Items 11 and 12 will be discussed at the next meeting due to lack of time and the very full agenda.</p> <p>InsideVue Mayonne Coldicott and David Shakeshaft met with Anne Walker and Dr John Omany on 7.2.11. All board members were circulated with MC's follow up letter to AW, stating her understanding of the PCT's position and requesting confirmation that this was correct. No reply has been received and in the absence of that, MC believes that the PCT has given all remaining resources to FPH to spend as they think fit, regardless of value for money and competition rules. There will be no audit trail to show how it has been spent.</p> <p>Dr Hugh O'Donnell said that InsideVue would continue to provide scans. JD sought clarification that they would result in a deficit at the start of the next financial year.
